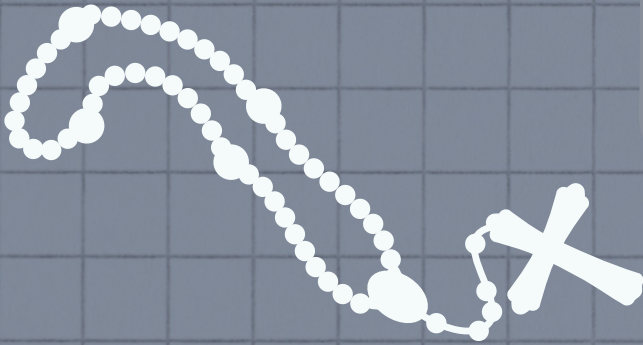
Solidarity Week

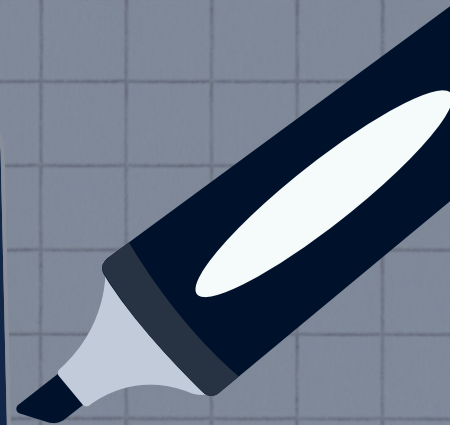
