Feels Like Fall!

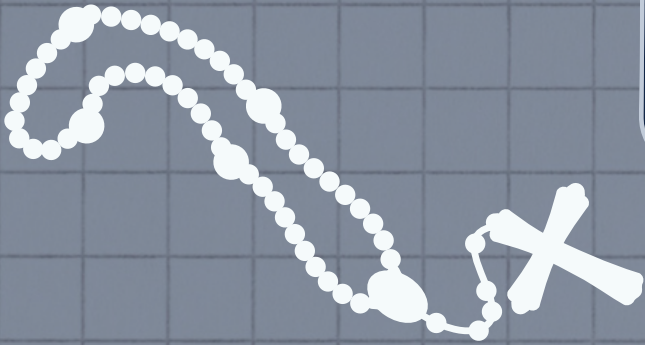
We welcome the week with a beautiful fall Monday morning. Our Angels will enjoy p.e. class and playing on the playground in this cooler weather.

Have a blessed week!

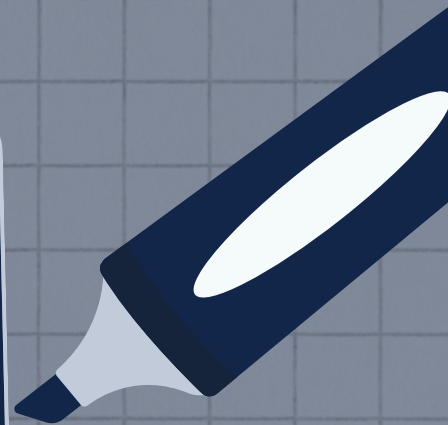
